

ZVEREV IN HOT WATER AFTER OUTBURST

WORLD number three Alexander Zverev has been booted out of a tennis tournament in Acapulco, Mexico and faces a hefty punishment for smashing an umpire's chair with his racket after a doubles match. The shocking incident occurred moments after the German and Brazilian partner Marcelo Melo were beaten by Britain's Lloyd Glasspool and Finland's Harri Heliövaara. Tournament organisers swiftly confirmed that Zverev would play no further part in the Mexican Open, his next opponent in the singles, Peter Gojowczyk, has been given a walkover.

BROOKS KOEPKA is relishing getting to grips with the 'Bear Trap' as he bids to halt his slide down golf's world rankings.

The Bear Trap is the nickname given to a daunting three-hole stretch – the 15th, 16th and 17th – at PGA National, a course designed by 'Golden Bear' Jack Nicklaus and the venue for the PGA Tour's Honda Classic. Koepka finished runner-up in 2019 as Keith Mitchell lifted the title with a winning total of nine under par and the four-time major winner is happy to tackle a tough layout after low scoring dominated the early part of the season. 'I like it because it's difficult,' said the former world number one, who has slipped to 15th in the rankings.

Elsewhere, Michaela Walsh was beaten by Russia's Vorontsova Liudmila in her featherweight quarter-final with three of the judges giving the last round to the Irishwoman.

LEWIS HAMILTON believes Formula One's stewards are biased and has demanded action to be taken ahead of the new season.

The 37-year-old British driver was back on track, two months and 11 days after he was denied a record-breaking eighth world championship, for the first day of winter testing at Barcelona's Circuit de Catalunya. Since the deeply controversial Abu Dhabi finale, the FIA has acted by firing Michael Masl – the man who bent the rules and allowed Max Verstappen the chance to take the title following a late safety car – in a revamp of race control. But Hamilton now says the sport's governing body must turn its attention to the stewards' room.

HIGGINS IS BLOWN AWAY BY FORD

FOUR-TIMES world champion John Higgins suffered a rare whitewash as the chance to claim the £150,000 prize for topping the BetVictor Series snooker rankings was wrenched from his grasp by Tom Ford. Ford wrapped up a 5-0 demolition of the Scot at the European Masters in Milton Keynes with a break of 127 as he surged into the fourth round. Higgins scored only 50 points in total with Ford dominating from the off with visits of 83, 68 and 87.
