Dunne plotting route back to World Tour

THE road to redemption for Paul Dunne begins today in the Dimension Data Pro-Am in Fancourt, South Africa.

The Greystones golfer, who led the Open after 54 holes at St Andrews in 2015, is seeking a route back to the DP World Tour via the Challenge Tour.

Dunne was once ranked 65th in the world but has slumped to 1,697 after a wretched run since he stared down Rory McIlroy to win the British Masters in 2017.

'It's been an interesting few years for me,' said the 29-year-old, who missed 18 cuts in 26

events in 2020 and 2021. Dunne is aiming to play a run of events and find some early season form.

'At this stage, you just want a bit of momentum, you want to get off to a good start to carry a bit of form into the next few weeks and then try and put yourself into contention as early as you can in the year.

'Then you're setting yourself up to win golf tournaments rather than just scrape through cut-lines. I've been at both ends of it

over the last six or seven years so I know one is definitely more fun than the other.'

'My goal for the year would be to win a tournament and get back on to the DP World Tour full-time, but right now my category is a bit more half and half, or even more towards Challenge Tour,' he added.

'I'm going to play four or five in a row now and get a feel for where things are competitively,' he added.
