Sexton said: "That's

"But also to remember what it's like so that if we do go back, potentially we've got two pool games, a potential quarter-final, semi-final and final all in that stadium."

Sexton hopes to return to the team to face Italy on Sunday but Iain Henderson has been ruled out with Covid-19.

The IRFU revealed that the Ulster lock returned a positive result during routine testing after the party reported back into camp on Monday.

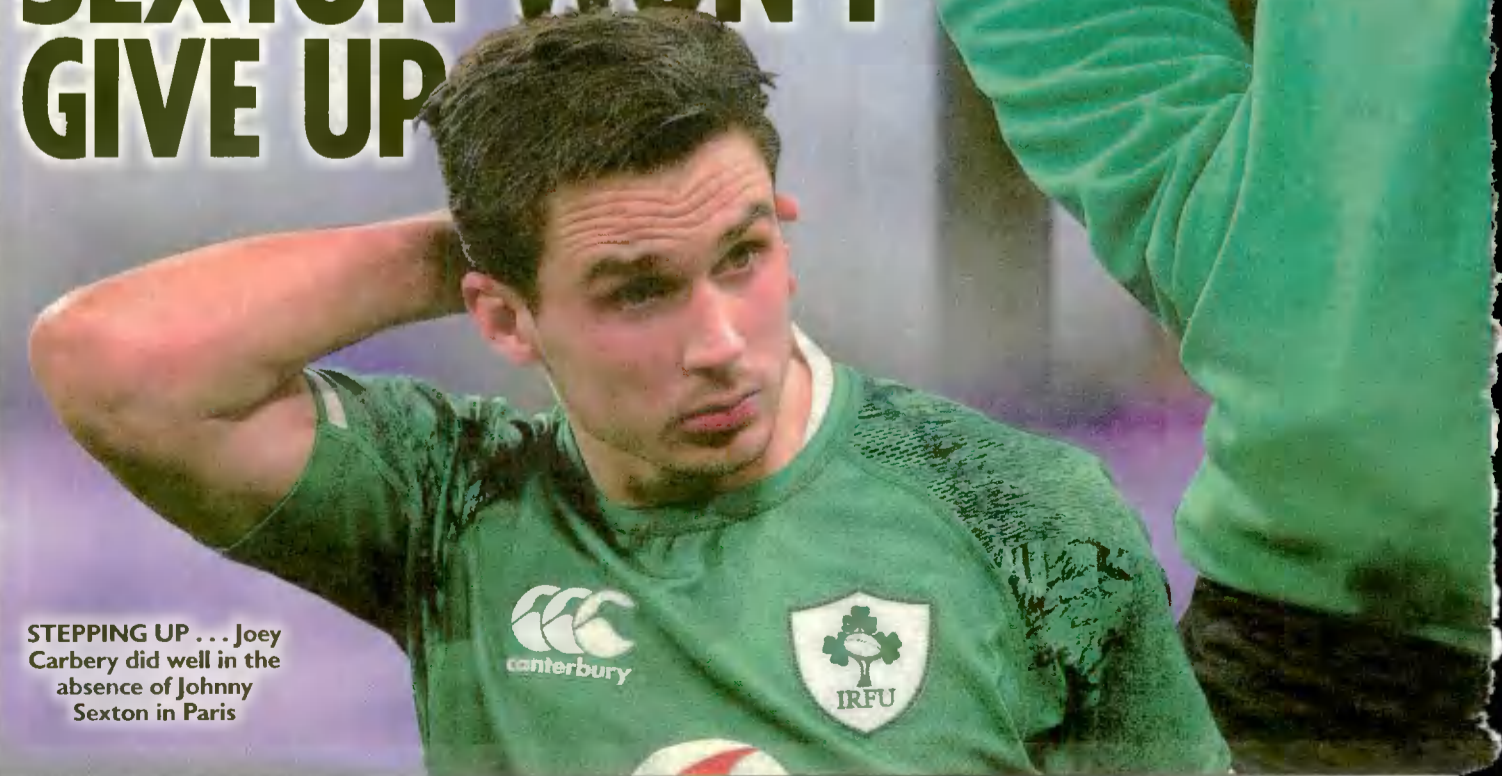
