

LOWRY'S PAIN PAIN

Irish star denied Honda Classic win by Austrian Straka

RAIN man Shane Lowry was denied a Honda Classic success by little known Austrian Sepp Straka.

Lowry, who won the Irish Open and The Open in the rain, was thwarted by a late downpour in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, and was unable to clinch the deal.

The Offaly native carded a superb 67 but fell one shot shy of a play-off when unable to match Straka's birdie on the 18th.

Even so, second place was worth \$874,000 and a bunch of FedEx Cup points for the 34-year-old Offaly man, who was looking to end a run of 61

events without a win. Competing in his first event on the PGA Tour this year, Lowry can take the positives of finding form ahead of The Players, and the Masters at Augusta National next month.

Five shots behind Daniel Berger entering the final round, Lowry instantly jumped into contention in a tense duel.

Berger, who was beaten by Padraig Harrington in a play-off for this coveted prize in 2015, was quickly reeled in by Lowry.

Berger coughed up four shots to par in the first six holes, while Lowry picked up two birdies at the first and fourth.

A stunned Berger was given a

lifeline when he holed from sand at the seventh for a birdie two but Lowry holed a 14-footer for a birdie on the 11th to pull one ahead on nine under.

Entering the closing four-hole stretch, known as The Bear Trap, it was the unheralded Straka who proved the main threat. Straka bravely holed birdie putts on the 14th and 16th to draw level with Lowry and smoked his drive 334 yards on the par five-18th before the heavens opened.

Straka followed up with a 201-yard approach to the green and calmly two-putted from 48 feet to post 10 under par.

Lowry, seeking to become the 13th Open champion to win the Honda Classic and follow Har-

ington on the roll of honour, was unable to match the birdie of Straka.

After pulling his tee shot, Lowry was forced to lay up in two and then dragged a wedge well left of the pin.

His 44-foot birdie putt to force a play-off came up a little shy as Straka became the first Austrian to win on the PGA Tour. Lowry did little wrong as he went bogey-free for his third successive 67, one shy of Straka's 66.

Meanwhile, Phil Mickelson will no longer serve as the host of the PGA Tour's American Express tournament in La Quinta, California, following the fallout over his comments about a proposed Saudi-backed league.
