McIlroy has the 17th to thank as Lowry makes hole-in-one

THE island green 17th hole at Sawgrass is a cruel mistress but it proved very kind to Rory McIlroy and Shane Lowry yesterday. Lowry lit up The Players at soggy Sawgrass with a hole in one at the iconic 17th. The 2019 Open champion celebrated as if Offaly had won the All-Ireland as his ball disappeared into the cup following a perfectly executed wedge to the island green. The roars reverberated around Ponte Vedra after Lowry became only the 10th golfer to make an ace on the hole that wreaked havoc in the second round. It was the first Sunday hole in one in The Players since 1997 and it catapulted Lowry to four under for the tournament, on the heels of the leaders. Improbably, Lowry completed the hole in just three strokes as earlier in the day he birdied the 17th as he finished two-three to

make the cut. McIlroy's good fortune came in an entirely different manner. He was heading for the unluckiest missed halfway cut of his career having battled the brutal gusts the previous day to play 21 holes in just one over par for a two-over total - but it appeared as if that would be one shot too many. Sixty-five players and ties make the cut and there were 65 on one over. Back at the 17th, American Scott Piercy, in the last group out, was on two under. For McIlroy to be given a lifeline, therefore, he needed Piercy to drop four shots in two holes. Piercy duly put two balls in the water and McIlroy was safe.
