TOTO WOLFF is ready to "take a chainsaw" to Lewis Hamilton's car before the second race of the season. The Mercedes boss watched his drivers claim third and fourth place in Bahrain in the season-opening Grand Prix.

But if it hadn't been for both Red Bulls having mechanical problems and retiring in the latter stages, Wolff's cars would have been nowhere in defence of their driver and constructor world titles.
Struggling
And after struggling with the new design and rules, there may be just one way to

Wolff (left) said: "It's easier to shed drag off the car because you simply take a chainsaw and cut the rear wing to bits, so that is what we will be doing for Jeddah."
