INVALID APPLICATION

An application for planning permission for Install a new LPG Safety Installation in a caged enclosure 1.8m x 1.2m x 1.2m (LxWxH) servicing the existing LPG storage installation with all ancillary services and associated site works. at Kishogue Park, Lucan, Co. Dublin was received from Ryan Beatty, Fingleton White the agent acting on behalf of the applicant Gas Networks Ireland on 29-Mar-2022 - Register Reference SD22A/0086, refers.

However, following an inspection it was found that the requirements of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) were not complied with for the following reason(s):

Article 20:- Article 20 states that the Site Notice shall be maintained in position on the land or structure concerned for a period of 5 weeks from date of receipt of application by the planning authority.

There was no notice on site on date of inspection.

Therefore, I recommend that (a) the planning application be deemed invalid in accordance with Article 26(4); (b) the applicant be informed that the application is INVALID – cannot be considered in accordance with Article 26(5)(a)(I) and; (c) all particulars, plans, drawings, maps submitted with the application be returned and the fee of \in 80 be refunded in accordance with Articles 26(5)(b) and 26(6) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended).
