Therefore, I recommend that (a) the planning application be deemed invalid in accordance with Article 26(4); (b) the applicant be informed that the application is INVALID – cannot be considered in accordance with Article 26(5)(a)(I) and; (c) all particulars, plans, drawings, maps submitted with the application be returned and the fee of \in 34 be refunded in accordance with Articles 26(5)(b) and 26(6) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended).
