  - (b) The applicant is requested to provide details on the quantities of discharge water from the pool to the existing public wastewater drainage network and frequencies of same. The applicant is required to engage with Irish Water through the submission of a Pre-Connection Enquiry (PCE) in order to determine the feasibility of existing connection to the public wastewater infrastructure. The Confirmation of Feasibility (COF) must be submitted to the planning department as the response to
