ON CUE: Jordan Brown poised for a Crucible return

JORDAN Brown stands one win away from finally getting to play in front of a Crucible crowd.

"I don't think any player thinks of Michael White as an amateur."

"He is a class act but it will be a best-of-19 frame match which I think suits me down to the ground and I can't wait until Tuesday."

Brown earned the right to face White by scraping past 15-year-old Liam Davies 6-5 in the previous round - and admitted that contest put him through the wringer.

Flustered

He added: "Even at 3-1 up Liam never looked flustered and I knew I was in for a tough game."

"For a 15-year-old...he is one of the best at that age I have ever seen. Remember that name."

"At 5-5 all sorts of thoughts were going through my mind, and this is what the World Championship does to you. It is horrible out there in the qualifiers, with so much pressure."

"I lost 6-5 last year, and at 5-5 this time I was just so determined not to have that happen again and lose another decider. It tests everything about you, and I was so relieved to win."

Stephen Maguire, meanwhile, has angrily called for heads to roll over the back to front tables at the qualifiers.

Scot Maguire beat China's Zhang Jankang 6-3 to reach the final tie as he bids to make it 19 consecutive appearances at the Crucible.

The last hurdle tomorrow is world No. 25 Zhou Yuelong but Maguire was furious about the table set-up at the low-key English Institute of Sport setting.

Maguire raged: "I just want to know whose idea it was to change the table round - and to put it upside down. How is that possible?"

"How can the black spot be where the crowd is? That has never happened since I have been a pro. 30 years. All of a sudden you are shooting into the crowd around the black."

"So any sort of movement in the crowd..."

"Whoever's idea that was to change the tables about needs to be sacked - it's that simple."

A World Snooker Tour spokesperson said: "We are aware of some issues relating to changing the venue layout."

"We are looking into this matter further and changes will be made when necessary going forward."
