

THE NEXT KELLIE?

GEORGIA McGovern's first day as a boxer ended with a bloody nose, but that didn't stop the then-seven-year-old from pressing on to become one of the most exciting talents in Ireland.

The Dubliner is a national champion, and at 17, she has already guaranteed herself a bronze medal at the European Youth Championship in Sofia after beating Hungary's Kata Pap in the quarter-final on Monday.

The Tallaght native's love affair

with the sweet science started as a young girl and she's since gone on to win national titles, as well as European silver medal as a schoolgirl.

"Believe it or not, it was a friend of her's from school who enticed her to come to a boxing class in her old gym," her father Darren explained from Bulgaria.

"That was when she was nearly eight years of age, and now we're here, she's fully dedicated to this sport and she's reaping the rewards now."

Underage Irish champion at 48kg, Georgia is balancing her life as a secondary school student with her work at the Setanta Boxing Academy in Newbridge.

"She is really dedicated. She trains five times a week, watches her diet — she's meticulous," her grandfather added.

"In fairness to her parents, they give her a lot of time. When she finishes school at 4.0, she'd be going training from around 5.30, most evenings."

"She's in against another strong opponent but Georgia has all the skills to beat anyone over here," Darren says.

"She's already been to the European Championships and came back with a silver medal. She has won national titles as well, she has plenty of experience so she's taking everything in her stride, and we're hoping for the best."
