MOFFETT LOOKS TO STAY AHEAD OF PACK IN CARLOW

THE Triton National Rally Championship returns to Carlow on Sunday after an absence of six years with series leader Josh Moffett (Hyundai) looking for a fourth consecutive win in the eight-round series...

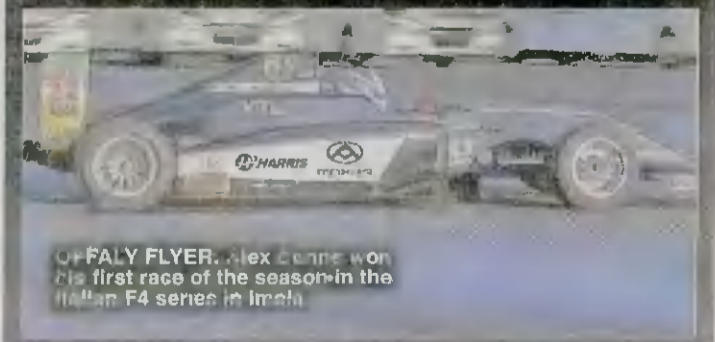
Others who will be in the mix will be three-time champion Declan Boyle (Ford Fiesta WRC) and Meath driver Tim McNulty, who made a return to racing earlier this year and who won the national series in 2011...

With the onus on costs, the Carlow Car Club only have two stages, each run three times. Drumflea at 19.1km and Ballintemple at just over 17km will offer the drivers some challenging runs on Sunday...

Championship leader Moffett, however, is not the No.1 seed - that honour falls to Ryan Loughran in his Ford Escort, having won the last staging of the Carlow Stages in 2018...

Loughran won't win the event this time against the more powerful and more modern R5 cars. Moffett in his Hyundai i20 R5 will run first on the road and another win will go a long way in his quest to win the Vard Trophy for the second time...
