**MOFFETT LOOKS TO STAY AHEAD OF PACK IN CARLOW**

**THE Triton National Rally Championship returns to Carlow on Sunday after an absence of six years with series leader Josh Moffett (Hyundai) looking for a fourth consecutive win in the eight-round series.**

VW Polo GTI R5. Last time out in Monaghan Gass finished third behind the Moffett brothers, Josh and Sam, while Barrable was fourth.

Gass has competed in all three rounds to date and is second in the series, 14 points behind Moffett, while Barrable, who missed the Birr round, is 28 points off the leader. "I had to skip the Birr Rally but with the best six from eight scores to count, there's a long way to go yet," said Barrable. "It was always going to be difficult in Monaghan as it was the home event for the Moffetts." Others who will be in the mix will be three-time champion Declan Boyle (Ford Fiesta WRC) and Meath driver Tim McNulty, who made a return to rallying earlier this year and who won the national series in 2011. McNulty will be out in his right-hand drive Ford Fiesta R5. Another former champion, Peadar Hurson (Ford Fiesta WRC), makes his first appearance in this year's championship, while Louth's Brendan Cumiskey (VW Polo GTI R5) and Maynooth's Paul Barrett (Ford Fiesta R5) complete the top ten. One interesting entry outside the top 10 is Dubliner Aaron MacHale, who won the national series in 2007 and makes a return to sport after an absence of three years, debuting a right-hand drive VW Polo GTI R5. The first of the day's stages gets underway at 10am with the finish ramp at the Seven Oaks Hotel in Carlow around 5pm. Meanwhile on the track, Offaly teenager Alex Dunne, the reigning Motorsport Ireland Young Racing driver of the Year, won his first race of the 2022 season in the Italian F4 series in Imola. Dunne also picked up two podium finishes in other races at Imola to put the 16-year-old Offaly driver into the lead in the championship.

Gass has already registered start-to-finish victories in Mayo, Birr and Monaghan and not only leads the National Championship but the senior Irish Tarmac two-day series too. The Irish Tarmac Rally Championship (ITRC) will resume with its fifth round in Donegal next month and in the meantime the Monaghan ace will be looking to extend his national series lead. Carlow has proved to be one of the popular rounds in the past, but it's been missing for the last few years. There are 150 crews taking part and over 50 others on the reserve list hoping to get into the Sheehy Motor Group Carlow Rally, based at the Seven Oaks Hotel in Carlow town.

**Costs**  
With the onus on costs, the Carlow Car Club only have two stages, each run three times. Drumfea at 19.1km and Ballintemple at just over 17km will offer the drivers some challenging runs on Sunday. Championship leader Moffett, however, is not the No.1 seed - that honour falls to Ryan Loughran in his Ford Escort, having won the last staging of the Carlow Stages in 2018. Loughran won't win the event this time against the more powerful and more modern R5 cars. Moffett in his Hyundai i20 R5 will run first on the road and another win will go a long way in his quest to win the Vard Trophy for the second time. Armagh's Darren Gass and Dubliner Robert Barrable are still very much in the equation after three rounds. Gass, a former ITRC winner, is adapting to his Citroen C3 while Barrable is getting to know his
