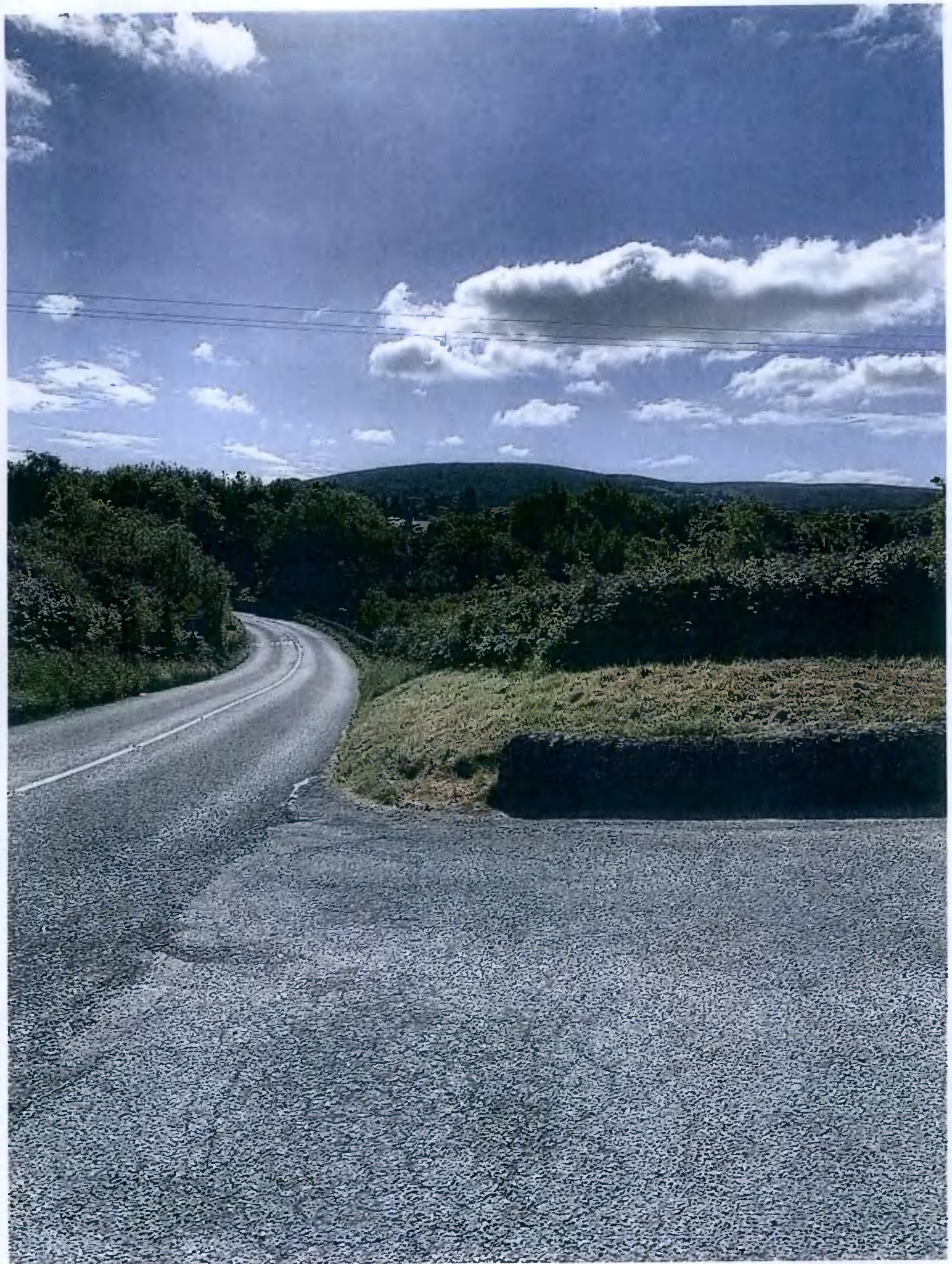

Further to the Agency's correspondence of 20/09/11 I wish to update you on the status of your complaint with regard to a site at Cruagh, Rockbrook, Dublin 16 (Site B).

South Dublin County Council provided the Agency with an update on the remediation of Site B in correspondence dated 19/01/11 (copy attached) along with a response to an Agency request for further details in correspondence dated 14/02/12 (copy attached).

Having regard to the investigations carried out by South Dublin County Council and subsequent remediation of the site I am to inform you that the Agency will not be pursuing the matter further at this time and considers its file closed. Any future concerns in relation to this matter should be addressed, preferably in writing, to South Dublin County Council, as it is the responsible authority in the first instance.

As stated previously the Agency is not in a position to make a determination on the land ownership issues in this case.
