

AMY Broadhurst and Lisa O'Rourke will both fight in a world championship final in Istanbul today after top displays in their semi-finals yesterday. It is the first time that Ireland will have two boxers fighting for gold medals at the same championships. The pair will aim to join Katie Taylor and Kellie Harrington on Ireland's roll call of female world champions. Italy's Dainese takes centre stage at Giro

ALBERTO Dainese became the first Italian winner in this year's Giro d'Italia yesterday, clinching victory with a well timed sprint in stage 11, a 203-kilometre (126.14 miles) ride from Santarcangelo di Romagna to Reggio Emilia. The 24-year-old surged past the favoured trio of French sprint leader Arnaud Demare, England's Mark Cavendish and Australian Caleb Ewan, before sprinting off his compatriot Simone Consonni to secure his maiden stage win. Colombian Fernando Gaviria (UAE Team Emirates) finished second and Consonni (Cofidis) came in third. Dainese was led out by DSM team mate Romain Bardet, who finished fourth in the general classification. "To win so close to home at the Giro d'Italia is unbelievable," said Dainese. Spaniard Juan Pedro Lopez retained his 12-second lead to hold on to the overall leader's pink jersey. Today's stage 12 is a challenging 204km ride from Parma to Genoa which features numerous climbs and a long descent.

the governing FIA, commercial rights holders Formula One Group, and the 10 teams — the three wings of the sport. Each has 10 votes, and a super majority of 26 is required to adopt the additional sprints.

Although the FIA blocked the plan at the meeting, Ben Sulayem said: 'I support the races if it is the right thing to do. This is for 2023, not this season. Our house isn't on fire. We have what is called a democracy: Formula One (Group) have a vote, the teams have a vote, I have a vote. If you then say I can't

abstain or take time to study the proposals then you are not allowing me the freedom of democracy.' He said he did not know who accused him of 'greed' in a leak to the press, but insisted: 'I did not ask for more money but if I had I would have wanted to use it in the right way — to invest in the proper regulation of the sport.'
