With reference to your planning application, received on 25-Apr-2022 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under Section 33 of the Planning & Development Act 2000, six copies of the following ADDITIONAL INFORMATION must be submitted.

- 1. The proposal, in its current form, is considered to have an unacceptable impact on amenity. The applicant is, therefore, requested to provide a revised proposal. This revision should:
  - Reduce the rearwards projection of the extension at first floor to ensure it does not fall within 45 degrees of the habitable windows of the adjacent properties
  - Provide an adequate level of screened amenity space to the rear of the proposed extension.
  - Provide internal floor to ceiling height of no less than 2.4m to ensure the proposed extension is habitable.
  - Ensure there are no windows on the side elevations.
  - Provide a schedule indicating how the revised apartment is in keeping with Sustainable Urban Housing: Design Standards for New Apartments (2020)

**NOTE**: The applicant should note that any submission made in repsonse to the above will be examined and MAY be deemed to be SIGNIFICANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION by the Planning Authority. In this event the applicant(s) will be subsequently notified and requested to publish a notice in an approved newspaper and erect or fix a site notice on the land or structure to which the further information relates and to submit copies of the both the newspaper and site notices to the Planning Authority in accordance with Article 35 (1) (a) and (b) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended).

**Note:** The applicant must submit the Further Information within **6 months** of the **date of decision**. If the information is not received within this period, the planning authority shall declare the application to be withdrawn.
