## **INVALID APPLICATION**

An application for planning permission for pay to use portable waste compactor for the acceptance of residual and food waste and a pay to use compactor for mixed dry recyclables. This activity requires the developers to possess a waste collection permit/certificate of registration at Newcastle Service Station, Ballynakelly, Newcastle, Co. Dublin was received from Ellen Reville the agent acting on behalf of the applicant BIGbin Waste Tech Ltd on 25-May-2022 - Register Reference SD22A/0151, refers.

However, following an inspection it was found that the requirements of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) were not complied with for the following reason(s):

Article 20:- Article 20 states that the Site Notice shall be maintained in position on the land or structure concerned for a period of 5 weeks from date of receipt of application by the planning authority.

No site notice erected on date of inspection 02/6/22.

Therefore, I recommend that (a) the planning application be deemed invalid in accordance with Article 26(4); (b) the applicant be informed that the application is INVALID – cannot be considered in accordance with Article 26(5)(a)(I) and; (c) all particulars, plans, drawings, maps submitted with the application be returned and the fee of  $\in$ 80 be refunded in accordance with Articles 26(5)(b) and 26(6) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended).
