Comments:

The proposed hip of the roof is considered token and should be more pronounced for it to be properly considered as a half hip/Dutch roof profile. The applicant must submit revised drawings showing a pronounced half-hip profile, of no less than 1/3 of the roof pitch, for the written agreement of the Planning Authority, noting that the angle of the hipped element of the half hip shall conform to the angle of the existing roof.
