E7 Objective 2: To encourage and support the development of solar energy infrastructure for local distribution, including solar PV, solar thermal and seasonal storage technologies."

We would ask that the council take into consideration the fact that the proposed change to No 2 Finnsgrove, may cause over shadowing to our existing solar installation.

Please see extract under Implementation 11.7.5

"11.7.5 SOLAR ENERGY Development proposals for solar energy development must: Prioritise south facing aspects and have an inclination of between approximately 35 and 50 degrees, depending on the use of solar PV or solar thermal technologies, Be designed to take account of over-shadowing from other solar installations on site and from existing elements of the built environment such as chimneys, parapet, roof plant equipment, taller buildings and structures in the immediate vicinity, Ensure that the siting and design of proposals have regard to the visual amenities of the surrounding area, and Consider the provisions of the Water Framework Directive, Habitats Directive and other environmental and built heritage issues."

We are personally trying to reduce our own carbon footprint in line with Government policy.

We trust you find these observations relevant to the application at hand and we hope they will receive the Council's full consideration.
