

WIFFEN SETS IRISH RECORD IN BUDAPEST

IRISH Olympian Daniel Wiffen got his World Championships underway by breaking the Irish 800m freestyle record yesterday, as he qualified for this evening's final in Budapest, Hungary. Swimming in heat three of four, the Armagh man clocked 7:46.32, knocking over four seconds off the previous record of 7:50.74, that he had set in April. The 20-year-old finished in fourth place in the heat, behind Tokyo 2020 bronze medallist Mykhalo Romanchuk (Ukraine) 7:44.75, Tokyo 2020 10K open water champion and 1500m bronze medallist Florian Wellbrock (Germany) 7:44.80 and was just .24 of a second behind Gabriele Detti of Italy in 7:46.03.

WORLD Athletics president Sebastian Coe has hinted track and field could follow swimming in banning transgender athletes. FINA, swimming's world governing body, has voted to stop transgender competitors from competing in women's elite races if they have gone through part of male puberty. American college swimmer Lia Thomas had already suggested she wanted to compete for the US Olympic squad, but the new rules mean she would be banned. Coe was at the the World Swimming Championships and suggested athletics may change its rules regarding transgender athletes.

'My responsibility is to protect the integrity of women's sport and we take that very seriously. If it means that we have to make adjustments to protocols going forward, we will,' he said. 'I've always made it clear: if we ever get pushed into a corner to that point where we're making a judgment about fairness or inclusion, I will always choose fairness. We have always believed biology trumps gender.'

HAMILTON TOLD NOT TO GET TOO CARRIED AWAY

MERCEDES boss Toto Wolff has warned Lewis Hamilton not to get too excited after the seven-time world champion secured his first podium since March 27 at the Canadian Grand Prix. Hamilton will head into his the British Grand Prix a week on Sunday with renewed rigour after he recovered from a back injury in Azerbaijan to finish third in Montreal. Max Verstappen took the chequered flag to claim his sixth win in nine appearances and Wolff said: 'One swallow doesn't make a summer. 'We saw that swallow in Barcelona but somehow it flew somewhere else. 'We need to be careful. There is so much work we need to do in order to be back at the front and we're not yet there.'
