

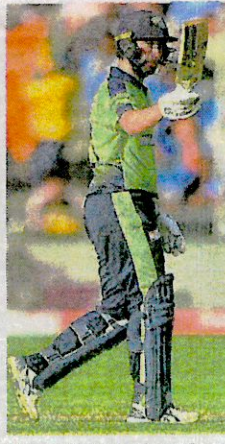
# Provinces get tricky Euro draws

# Ireland give India hard fight

**IRELAND** pushed India all the way before eventually succumbing by just four runs in the second and final T20 international at Malahide yesterday. India, one of the powerhouses of the game, on the first T20 comfortably and were expected to cruise yesterday's game after posting a huge 225 for seven in their innings. Deepak Hooda top-scored with a stunning 104 while Sanju Samson contributed an excellent 77. It was a massive total for Ireland to chase in such limited time but they made a tremendous attempt to haul in the visitors before coming up just short at 221-5.

## CRICKET

Captain Andy Balbirnie top-scored for Ireland with 60 while opener Paul Stirling contributed 40. Harry Tector and George Dockrell chipped in with 39 and 34 not out respectively. For India, Bhuvneshwar Kumar, Harshal Patel, Ravi Bishnoi and Umrah Malik took a wicket apiece.
