Removal of Side Entrance

The Public Realm Section welcomes the fact the applicant has removed the side gate form the

proposed scheme.

The Public Realm Section has assessed the proposed development in accordance with the policies

and objectives of the County Development Plan 2016-2022 and with best practice guidelines and

recommends the following CONDITIONS be applied to any proposed GRANT of permission.

1. Sustainable Drainage System (SuDS)

No development shall take place until details of the implementation; maintenance and management

of the sustainable drainage scheme have been submitted to and approved by the Planning Authority.

The applicant shall submit a drawing in plan and cross-sectional views clearly showing proposed

Sustainable Drainage Systems (SuDS) features for the development. Sample SuDs devices include

green roofs, water butts, tree pits, rain gardens, filter strips and permeable paving amongst others.

The applicant is referred to the recently published SDCC SuDS Design Guide for further information

and guidance.

REASON: To prevent the increased risk of flooding and to improve and protect water quality, in

accordance with policies under Section 8.4.0 Sustainable Urban Drainage Systems of the CDP 2016-

22 in particular G5 Objective 1 and G5 Objective
