RONAN O'GARA could be about to wreak even more calendar year damage to Irish club rugby!

Hot on the heels of defeating Leinster in the Heineken Cup final last May, he will be bringing European champions La Rochelle to Belfast the week before Christmas.

It could make for a tricky Heineken round-two tie for Ulster, as it comes on the back of opening up the week beforehand away against Sale.

Moreover, a win for ROG could fuel speculation the IRFU will move for him to succeed Andy Farrell as Ireland's series win in New Zealand has complicated the current Ireland coach's future.

Expected
The IRFU had been expected to tie Farrell down to a further four-year deal, to run from 2024 to 2027, with an announcement pencilled in following finalising August-September negotiations.

However, there has been growing speculation England will make a move for Farrell to succeed Eddie Jones, which brings the financial aspect of any prospective IRFU deal into sharp focus.

Jones is the world's highest paid Rugby Union coach, earning £800,000 (€939,000)
