Public Consultation

Padraig Thornton Waste Disposal Ltd (Thornton Recycling) proposes expanding an existing Material Recovery Facility (MRF) situated at Unit 1 Industrial Park, Ballycoolin Road, Dublin 11. The development will involve the construction and expansion of an expanded MRF and ancillary infrastructure on a development site (3.4 hectares) encompassing 1 site as well as lands directly south of the existing site. Bord Pleanála have determined that the development constitutes Strategic Infrastructure Development under the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended). Thornton Recycling will apply for permission to carry out this proposed development under Section 5 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended).
