#### **Surface Water Report:**

#### **Further Information required:**

1.1 The applicant has proposed to discharge surface water run off from the proposed development to the foul water drainage network. The applicant is required to submit a drawing showing the existing Surface Water drainage network. The applicant is also required to submit a drawing showing revised proposed drainage showing separation of foul and surface water drainage. If separation of surface water and foul water drainage systems is not feasible on the site and all alternatives have been considered, such as SuDS features, then the applicant is required to submit a Letter of agreement from Irish Water to the planning authority which clearly states that Irish Water are in agreement with the applicant's proposal to connect surface water drainage from the proposed development into the existing foul water drainage network.

- 1.2 The applicant has not proposed any SuDS (Sustainable Drainage Systems) features for the proposed development. The applicant is required to submit a drawing in plan and cross sectional views clearly showing proposed Sustainable Drainage Systems (SuDS) features for the development. Examples include but are not limited to:
  - Rain Gardens, Planter boxes with overflow connection to the public surface water sewer.
  - Swale
  - Permeable Paving
  - Grasscrete
