for development at this site, to the east of Kishoge Community College, at Thomas Omer Way, Balgaddy, Lucan, Co. Dublin. The application site is located within the Clonburris Strategic Development Zone (SDZ).

The development will consist of the construction of a new primary school. The proposed primary school will extend to c3,355sq.m will be 2 storeys in height and will comprise 16 no. classrooms with an additional 2 classroom Special Educational Needs Unit; a General Purpose Hall and all ancillary teacher and pupil amenities and facilities. The proposed development also provides for hard and soft play areas, including 2 no. outdoor ball courts, bicycle parking, staff car parking, vehicle drop off and set down areas. Photovoltaic Panels (PV) are proposed on roofs in addition to EV Charging Points and a packaged Biomass heating plant. The proposed development also provides for all landscaping and boundary treatments and all associated site development works.

Access to the site will be via a new junction and access road off Thomas Omer Way. The new access road will run south off Thomas Omer Way and then west into the site. The proposed access road is in accordance with the Clonburris Strategic Development Zone (SDZ) Planning Scheme and incorporates public lighting, footpaths and cycle tracks. A further pedestrian / cycle only connection to Thomas Omer Way is also proposed along the western green corridor, west of the proposed school building.

The planning application may be inspected or purchased at the offices of South Dublin County Council, County Hall, Town Centre, Tallaght, Dublin 24 during its public opening hours of Monday to Friday from 9:00am to 4:00pm., and may also be viewed on the Council's website – [www.sdcc.ie](http://www.sdcc.ie).

A submission or observation in relation to the application may be made in writing to South Dublin County Council on payment of a fee of €20 within 5 weeks of receipt of the application by South Dublin County Council and such submissions or observations will be considered by the Planning Authority in making a decision on the application. The Planning Authority may grant permission subject to or without conditions or may refuse to grant permission.
