5% (Browntop Bent) + Sowing rate: 35g/m2 (350kgs/ha)

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Open space grass seed with Coburns "Low Maintenance" mix or similar

Private Gardens lawn seed with Coburns "Low Maintenance" mix or similar 60% (Perennial Ryegrass) + 35% (Slender Creeping Red Fescue)
