Prior to commencement of development the applicant shall agree in writing with the planning authority the final layout of the 4,400 square metres area of public open space at the eastern boundary of the site.

Reason: in the interests of clarity and to ensure an appropriate high standard of development.

#### **Condition 8**

The boundary planting and areas of communal open space and public open space shall be landscaped in accordance with the landscape scheme submitted to An Bord Pleanala with this application, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the planning authority. The landscape scheme shall be implemented fully in the first planting season following completion of the development, and any trees or shrubs which die or are removed within three years of planting shall be replaced in the first planting season thereafter. This work shall be completed before any of the dwellings are made available for occupation. Access to green roof areas shall be strictly prohibited unless for maintenance purposes.

Reason: In order to ensure the satisfactory development of the public open space areas, and their continued use for this purpose.

### Response:

The boundary planting and areas of communal open space and public open space shall be landscaped in accordance with the landscape scheme submitted to An Bord Pleanala with this application, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the planning authority.

We have been in communication with South Dublin County Council Parks Department and we have noted the poor condition of the trees on the western boundary. Please see attached Arboricultural Impact Assessment & Tree Protection Plan and Arboricultural Tree Survey Report. The trees are shown as poor and should be removed.

We wish to remove the trees of poor quality and replace with large semi

mature Oak trees and pine trees. Furthermore we wish to grade the ground levels and tie in with the previous landscape development of the open space adjacent to this proposal.

The landscape scheme shall be implemented fully in the first planting season following completion of the development, and any trees or shrubs which die or are removed within three years of planting shall be replaced in the first planting season thereafter, this shall reside with the management company. This work shall be completed on a phased basis before any of the dwellings are made available for occupation. Access to green roof areas shall be strictly prohibited unless for maintenance purposes.
