

Proposed development at Hillhouse, Lucan Road, Lucan, Co Dublin

Dear Sir/Madam

We wish to make the following observations/objections on the above Application:

## 1. Access/Road Safety:

The proposed entrance onto Lucan Road is adjacent to an extremely busy junction and close to the Church and schools. In reality this road is now part of the Outer Ring Road system which connects the N7, N4 and N3 motorways via the Liffey Bridge in Lucan village. The junction near the proposed entrance is extremely busy, with long queues inbound and outbound at peak times — morning and evening and afternoons at school times. The footpath is also extremely busy with schoolchildren accessing schools and parishioners attending Church. Vehicles attempting to enter or exit the proposed development will face serious safety hazards and existing road users will be expected to stop in their lanes to facilitate access. In my opinion a yellow box on the road would not lessen the risks to road users.

## 2. Car parking:

While 11 car parking spaces may be appropriate for the development, in reality the number of cars will be greater than this. So there will be an overspill of car parking from the proposed development into adjacent areas, e.g. Lucan Heights and the Cloisters. These areas are already busy at school drop off/ collection times.

## 3. Scale of the proposed development:

The proposed development consisting of 4 storeys is out of character with the surrounding area containing single and two storey dwellings and it would overlook the two storey houses in Lucan Heights and the Cloisters as well as the nearby Convent and school.
