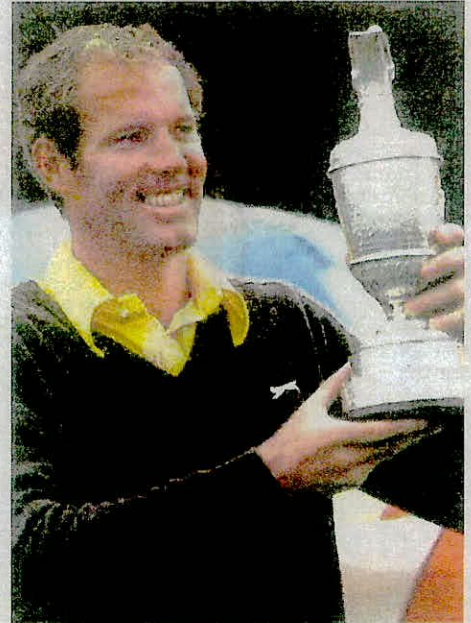


# Lowry just misses out on FedEx finale but Seniors Tour glory for Harrington



Crowning glory: Tom Weiskopf celebrates his 1973 Open win

THERE was heartache for Shane Lowry in Delaware last night as he narrowly missed out on booking his place in the field for the lucrative Tour Championship in Atlanta. After carding a final round of 68 to tie the 12th on eight under in the BMW Championship, Lowry faced an agonising wait to see if his total was good enough to make the top 30 in the FedEx Cup rankings. Lowry was lying 31st and needed a favour from others yet to finish. After Sahith Theegala holed an eight-footer on the last for par, and Corey Connors made birdie there, Lowry needed either Aaron Wise or Adam Scott to wobble down the stretch. Wise coughed up three shots on the 15th and 16th but made a brave par on the last after finding sand off the tee for a 73 and his seven under par total kept him in 30th, one place ahead of Lowry. That left Scott as the last man between Lowry and the FedEx

Cup finale. The Aussie was 29th in the standings playing the final hole where his drive stopped on the fringe of a bunker. Scott had to stand in the trap to play his second shot, and found another bunker by the green. He then executed a remarkable recovery from 33 yards to save par. He was in and Lowry was out. Seamus Power missed out on the Atlanta finale with a closing 75 for seven over par which left him 42nd in the FedEx Cup places. On the Champions Tour, Pdraig Harrington breezed to a three-stroke victory over Thongchai Jaidee in the Dick's Sporting Goods Open in Endicott, New York. Harrington's final round of 67 gave him a 16 under par total and secured his second win to follow his US Open victory in June. The cheque for \$315,000 took

Harrington's winnings past the \$2m mark for the season. Darren Clarke (69) tied sixth on ten under. Meanwhile, Tom Weiskopf, the former Open champion once known as the 'Towering Inferno' for his famous temper, has died at the age of 79. His death, two years after he was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer, was announced on social media by Tom Watson. 'I send my deepest sympathies to the family of Tom Weiskopf,' wrote the five-time Open champion. 'Will miss you and your stories. RIP my friend.' PGA Tour commissioner Jay Monahan said in a statement: 'The PGA Tour is saddened at the passing of Tom Weiskopf, a towering figure in the game of golf not only during his playing career but through his accomplished work in the broadcast booth and golf course design business. Tom is leaving behind a lasting legacy in golf. The beautiful swing he showcased is still being emulated, while

his golf courses remain as testaments to his love for the game. Our hearts and deepest sympathies are with his wife, Laurie, two children, Heidi and Eric, and the entire Weiskopf family during this time.' The Ohio native's crowning moment came when he won the 1973 Open at Troon, finishing three strokes clear of fellow American Johnny Miller and England's Neil Coles. Weiskopf also claimed 12 top-five major finishes and 16 victories on the PGA Tour, though many felt he would have won more had his temperament not intervened. In retirement, Weiskopf became one of the game's most celebrated course architects. One of his designs, Loch Lomond, in partnership with Jay Morrish, is considered among the finest courses in the world. Meanwhile, Germany's Max Kieffer won his first DP World Tour title at the 249th attempt at the D+D Real Czech Masters yesterday.
