

Walsh's transfer to Crokes approved

GALWAY star Shane Walsh's contentious transfer to Kilmacud Crokes has been given the green light by Croke Park. The GAA's Central Competitions Control Committee (CCCC) approved Walsh's application yesterday, clearing the way for Walsh (right) to leave his home club Kilkerrin-Clonberne and play for this year's All-Ireland club finalists in the Dublin championship. His home club had initially intimated their opposition to the transfer but decided on reflection to accede to Walsh's request for a transfer on the basis that he lives in Dublin, where he is studying. Meanwhile, Tipperary hurling boss Liam Cahill has received another blow with the news that first-choice defender Craig Morgan will be sidelined for most of next year after rupturing his cruciate ligament while on club duty last weekend.
