'I send my deepest sympathies to the family of Tom Weiskopf,' wrote the five-time Open champion. 'Will miss you and your stories. RIP my friend.' PGA Tour commissioner Jay Monahan said in a statement: The PGA Tour is saddened at the passing of Tom Weiskopf, a towering figure in the game of golf not only during his playing career but through his accomplished work in the broadcast booth and golf course design business. Tom is leaving behind a lasting legacy in golf. The beautiful swing he showcased is still being emulated, while

testaments to his love for the game. Our hearts and deepest sympathies are with his wife, Laurie, two children, Heidi and Eric, and the entire Weiskopf family during this time.'
The Ohio native's crowning moment came when he won the 1973 Open at Troon, finishing three strokes clear of fellow American Johnny Miller and England's Neil Coles.
