It has come to the attention of the South Dublin County Childcare Committee (SDCCC) that the Early Learning and Care Service at the above address is facing issues concerning their planning application and wish to provide this letter as support for the service.

We are aware of the service, which is run by Linda McQuaid and registered with Tusla TU2015DS185. From the numbers attending the service, which caters for both preschool and afterschool children aged between 2 - 12 years, we can observe that the service is required in the area as the occupancy rates are always very positive. The service caters for 32 children from the local community, and anecdotally we know that the service operates a substantial waiting list annually. Our local information on the need in this area identifies that a service closure would result in inadequate early years and school-aged childcare provision locally. In addition, the loss of this service would disadvantage the community of parents and children who use the service.

SDCCC considers this early learning and care, and school-aged childcare service should continue to operate and consider the planning department should award any planning retention of the premises that is required.
