Further to your correspondence dated 22th July 2022. Please find enclosed response documents to the request for additional information:

The Planning Authority deem there is scope on this site to accommodate a bungalow
extension, however it would have to be significantly redesigned and substantially reduced in
size and scale. In its present context it is not considered the proposal would have an
acceptable impact on visual amenity. Given the above, it is not considered that the proposal
meets the requirements of Policy H27. The planning authority has concerns that the
proposed extension would fail to appear subservient to the main dwelling and would not

complement it. It is considered that the proposal is an overdevelopment of the existing semi-detached bungalow in size and scale at a current width of 13.6.m along the western side of this Rural site.

(i) the applicant is requested to provide a redesign with a significant reduction in scale and size to lessen the impact of the proposed extension and resubmit fully contiguous, elevational and sectional drawings.

## Response:

- (i) Please refer to the revised drawings (E), (F), (H), (I), and (J) which deals with all matters of the above request.
- 2. The planning authority note anomalies in the submitted drawings and the omission of specific details where the rear extension is not joined to the main dwelling. Accurate drawings are required for the planning authority to assess the said proposal fully with site levels and entire structures on site. The applicant is requested to submit revised drawings to address the following:
