DANIIL MEDVEDEV lost his cool with the French crowd at the Moselle Open in Metz during a second-round defeat by Stan Wawrinka.

The Russian, playing his first match since losing his world No.1 ranking and US Open title, saved a match point during the second-set tie-break only to drop serve at the start of the decider.

Having been warned for smashing a

ball high into the stands, Medvedev then earned boos for flinging his racket across the court. He took exception to the reaction of the crowd, jeering and gesturing repeatedly before the match continued, with Wawrinka clinching a 6-4 6-7 (7) 6-3 victory. It was a significant victory for threetime grand slam champion Wawrinka, now ranked down at 284. The 37-yearold had not beaten a top-10 player for nearly two years but found some of his old form to stun the top seed. Medvedev pulled himself together to get back on serve in the final set only to lose the final three games. Earlier, second seed Hubert Hurkacz defeated Dominic Thiem, who continues to struggle.
