With reference to your planning application, received on 01-Sep-2022 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under Section 33 of the Planning & Development Act 2000, six copies of the following ADDITIONAL INFORMATION must be submitted.

1. Having regard to the existing roof profiles in the area, a full gable roof is considered inconsistent and out of character. The applicant is requested to submit revised drawings clearly showing a 'Dutch' hip roof profile. The 'Dutch' hip should maintain the same angle as the existing hip roof of the dwelling and should not be 'token' and should be clearly distinguishable from a full gable roof and should leave sufficient head height for the new attic stairwell.

NOTE: The applicant should note that any submission made in repsonse to the above will be examined and MAY be deemed to be SIGNIFICANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION by the Planning Authority. In this event the applicant(s) will be subsequently notified and requested to

publish a notice in an approved newspaper and erect or fix a site notice on the land or structure to which the further information relates and to submit copies of the both the newspaper and site notices to the Planning Authority in accordance with Article 35 (1) (a) and (b) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended).

Note: The applicant must submit the Further Information within 6 months of the date of decision. If the information is not received within this period, the planning authority shall declare the application to be withdrawn.
