'We have our players' backs and will press our case in court against the PGA's anti-competitive behaviour.'

Both Mickelson and Poulter said, with LIV joining the lawsuit, they

no longer felt they needed to pur-

sue the case individually. 'With LIV's involvement in these issues, the players' rights will be protected and I no longer feel it is necessary for me to be part of the proceedings,' Mickelson said in a

statement.
Poulter, who also was among a number of players to apply for an injunction against the DP World Tour in order to allow them to play in July's Scottish Open and subsequent events, had a similar view.
