Dear Sirs.

As a next-door neighbour to 17 Rossberry Lane, Lucan I would like to object to a planning application, ref # SD22B/0438 for following reasons:

- It seems to me that the submitted existing and proposed floor and elevation plans may not be factually correct. Please note that:
  - there is a roofed and gated structure attached to the side of the house (over a side corridor) that is not shown on either exiting or proposed floor plans (please find pictures attached)
  - o there is an additional structure to the rear of the house that is not shown on either existing or proposed floor plans (please find pictures attached).
- Given all developments and extensions built on this property already, apparently resulting in an increase of floor size of the property of about 50% over the original floor size, I strongly feel that proposed development would further result in a significant overdevelopment of the property.
- Given the size and shape of existing developments on the property, I feel that any further developments would put it even more out of character with other properties in the vicinity.
- There are no dormer windows overlooking the garden space between Rossberry Lane and the opposite street (see picture attached). I feel that a dormer window would infringe a right to privacy for residents of properties that share a back garden space with 17 Rossberry Lane.
- To the best of my knowledge, no other property in the vicinity or in the estate has a frontporch altered in the proposed fashion and I believe that the proposed development would be out of character with the front sides of existing houses in the area.
- Increasing floor size and at the same time decreasing car park space in front of the property
  could potentially result in an increase in traffic movement, traffic congestion and a take-up
  of publicly available car park spaces, which are already in a very limited supply in the
  vicinity.

I feel that this development would set an undesirable precedent for other developments which would in themselves and cumulatively seriously injure the residential amenities in the area and in my opinion contravene the zoning objectives for the area. I would kindly ask to consider the above mentioned reasons favourably and reject planning application, ref # SD22B/0438.
