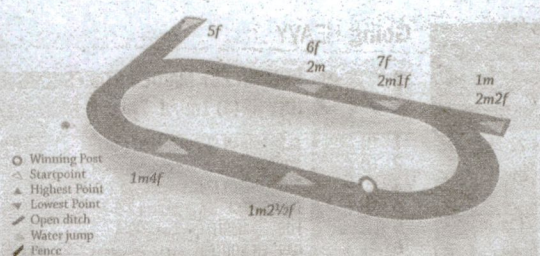

DUNDALK NEXT IN EPIC RACE

COLIN Keane and Billy Lee take their title battle to Dundalk this afternoon — the third-last meeting in the Irish flat racing season.

It all ends at Naas on Sunday, and with Keane and Lee locked together on 89 winners each, it promises to be a fascinating finish with another Dundalk meeting also scheduled for Friday. Much will depend on the outcome of an appeal hearing this morning where Limerickman Lee will attempt to get a two-day suspension quashed.

He picked up the ban for his use of the whip in a race at Dundalk last week where he appeared to go one over the eight-stroke limit when winning on Beleaguement — a horse he also rides today. Lee told the stewards that two of those strokes were for corrective purposes, which is permitted. The appeal hearing will be at 9.30am and a victory would go a long way towards the 36-year-old winning a first ever jockey's championship.

His friend and rival Keane drew level at Galway on Monday as he attempts to win a fourth crown and he can edge clear following the opening Dundalk Stadium Claiming Race.

Conditions

BUCKY LARSON (2.00) is a reliable seven-year-old that's won six times for Ger Lyons and he looks well enough treated by conditions of this contest.

Keane won on him here in July over this trip and although this is a very modest race a win would be very valuable in the Meath man's title ambitions.

Lee can strike back though immediately CEDAR RAPIDS (2.30) in the 1m Handicap. Joseph O'Brien knows all about winning jockeys titles and he can land a middle of the card double with QUEEN MAEDBH (3.00) and SHADOWED (3.30).

Queen Maedbh is a Gleneagles filly that looked the part when runner-up at Leopardstown on her racecourse debut while Shadowed should also prove hard to beat having chased home subsequent Group 1 winner Auguste Rodin at Naas.

The nap vote goes to COMPANY KEEPING (4.30) in the 7f Handicap. He was only beaten a neck here by Beleaguement here last time out and a 2lbs rise might not stop him getting a deserved success for Patrick Delaney and Emmet McNamara.
