

















LEGEND

-  Existing woodland belts to be retained and strengthened
-  Proposed woodland belts and copses
Triple lines of large native trees with understorey of native shrubs, small trees and groundcover create an instant dense woodland route to facilitate the unobstructed movement of fauna through the site. Large coniferous trees provide shelter and shade all year round. Accommodates larger fauna. Flowering plants attracts pollinating insects and birds.
-  Proposed SUDS features
Wetlands, bioretention ponds and swales. Creates unique types of habitats for certain flora and fauna, including many pollinators.
-  Proposed Meadows
Area managed as a native meadow grassland, including native wetland meadow areas.
-  Proposed Improved Riparian Strip
Rivers edge regraded in sections to increase width of riparian edge. Area to be seeded with wetland wildflower mix.

-  Woodland proposed and to be installed under separate planning permission
-  Meadow proposed and to be installed under separate planning permission
-  SUDS features proposed and to be installed under separate planning permission
-  Existing tree belts and hedgerows on surrounding lands
-  Existing woodland blocks on surrounding lands
-  Existing woodland blocks on surrounding lands

-  Existing tree lined avenues on surrounding lands
-  Green infrastructure links between proposed development and surrounding lands
-  Green infrastructure links to surrounding GI corridors as identified on SDCCs GI Plan for the County
