

Tucker pluck not enough

IRELAND battled bravely but were ultimately undone by a brilliant display of fast-bowling by Australia's lethal quickies.

They went down to a 42-run defeat in the Men's T20 World Cup game in Brisbane, but thanks to Lorean Tucker the margin was a lot narrower than expected.

The Dubliner played the innings of his life in front of a partisan Gabba crowd, scoring an unbeaten 71 off 48 balls, becoming the leading run-scorer in the competition. However, the rest of his team collapsed in a Halloween horror show with the next best score just 14.

The Aussies had made 179, a testing score and Tucker came in at 18-1 when Andy Balbirnie was dismissed. He still hadn't scored a run when Ireland collapsed to 25-5 with Mitchell Starc and Glenn Maxwell each picking up two wickets in an over.

ied the ship and played a series of stunning shots including a huge six into the grandstand. Tucker was particularly severe on Starc, scoring 37 off the 18 balls he faced off the left-armers.

He eventually ran out of partners, just as Irish fans were starting to dream the impossible. It leaves Ireland unlikely to reach the semi-final but Tucker's defiance did a huge favour to England who remain ahead of Australia on run-rate - the Eng-

land supporters club renamed their twitter account Lorean Tucker's Barmy Army last night. Australia had lost their dangerous David Warner for 3 to Barry McCarthy's first delivery and he picked up Mitchell Marsh off the

first ball of his second over too, as Australia found it tricky against a mostly disciplined attack.

The big all-rounder also won a standing ovation for a stunning piece of fielding, diving full length to hold a catch with his left hand and, realising he was heading over the boundary, flung the ball back into play, saving four runs.

He finished with 3-29 and Josh Little also took 2-21 in an excellent spell. Maxwell fell 'caught Tucker bowled Little' - the 14th time the combination has struck, a world record since T20Is began.

But Mark Adair had another off day, bowling five wides in the 15th over, which went for 26 even with McCarthy saving that four.

Bizarrely, Balbirnie entrusted Adair with the final over - which cost 17 more. He ended with 0-59, Ireland's most expensive spell at any T20 World Cup.

Since his 2-39 against Zimbabwe, the CIYMS man has bowled 16 overs, taking 1-134.

To reach the semi Ireland now need to hammer New Zealand on Friday and hope other results go their way.
