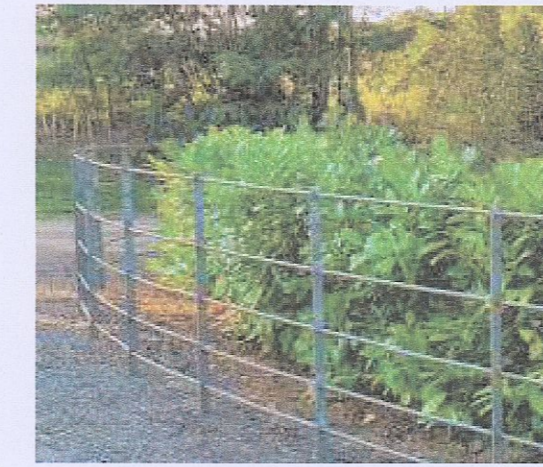

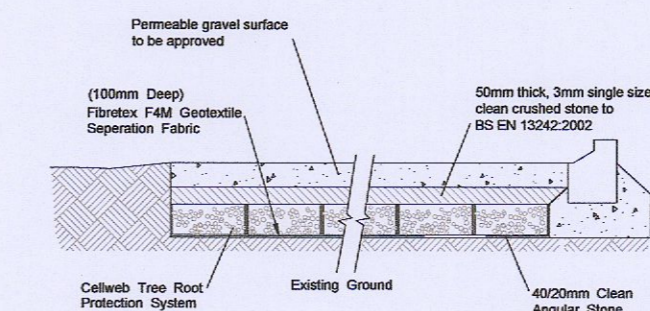


Seasonal planting colour palette

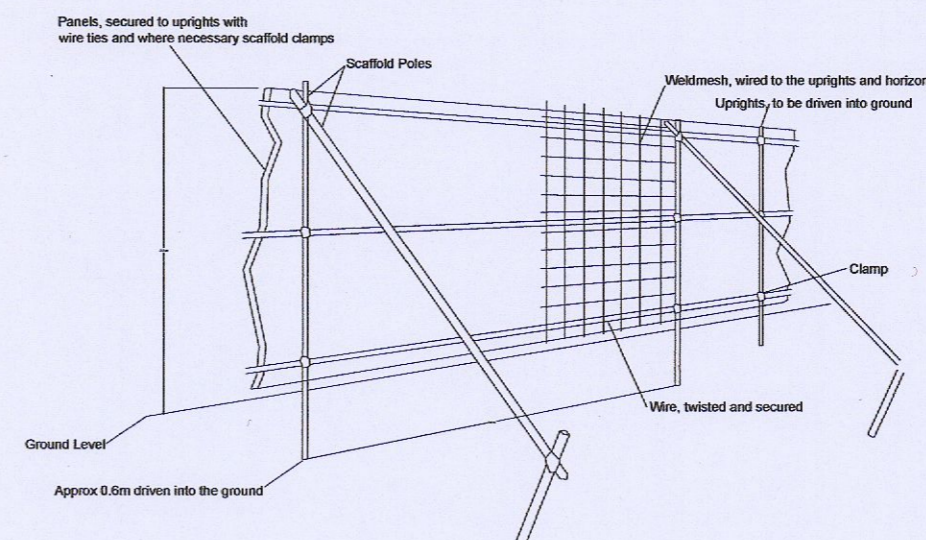
