I refer to your submission received on 04-Oct-2022 to comply with Condition No 5 of Grant of Permission No. SD21A/0181, in connection with the above.

In this regard I wish to inform you that the submission received is deemed **not** compliant.

Comments:

"The documents provided by the Applicant have been assessed by the Parks and Public Realm, with their Assessment noting the following main concerns:



- o Impacts of the proposed development on existing trees, hedgerows and local biodiversity. The proposal lacks street trees and has floodlighting that may on local biodiversity including bats.
- o Impacts of the proposed development on green and blue infrastructure the proposals lack a landscape plan with details. There are no details of the planting of SUDS features.
- The submitted scheme details an ornamental planting scheme but does not address our concerns about a lack of trees and has no details on the SUDs proposals.'

Having regard to the concerns of the Parks and Public Realm Department, it is considered that the submission is not Compliant with Condition 5. "
