Prior to commencement of any works in the public domain, and in order to comply with The Roads Act 1993 Section 13 Paragraph 10, a Road Opening Licence must be secured from South Dublin County Council, Roads Maintenance Department.

Description:

Ground floor extension to rear (to create family ancillary accommodation) with internal modifications and associated site works.



Access & Roads Layout:

There is an existing vehicular entrance to the rear and off laneway. This entrance is not accurately detailed on the submitted drawings and a revised drawing will be required.

The proposed building is likely to affect turning movements for vehicles egressing. AutoTRAK analysis of how vehicles can safely egress will be required also.

Roads recommend that additional information be requested from the applicant:

- 1. Applicant to submit a revised fully dimensioned layout detailing the existing/proposed vehicular entrance.
- 2. Applicant to submit AutoTRAK analysis showing how vehicles can safely egress the site.
