



Making her mark: Ireland's Gaby Lewis INPHO

Lewis and Hunter set Ireland up for historic win in Pakistan

A STUNNING opening stand of 110 by Gaby Lewis and Amy Hunter set up Ireland for a historic series win against Pakistan on their first visit to the country. With the three-match T20I series levelled at 1-1, Ireland trounced the hosts by 34 runs in the decider in Lahore.

After Ireland opted to bat, Lewis and Hunter fell just two short of the partnership record set by Lewis and Orla Prendergast against Holland in 2019.

The pair found plenty of gaps in the field and finished the powerplay on 56-0 and at drinks after ten overs they had gone on to 87-0.

Lewis led from the front with a 26-ball half-century, the fastest for Ireland since Nikki Symmons' 24 ball blitz in 2010.

Nashra Sandhu dismissed Hunter for 40, and Lewis fell two overs later for a 46-ball 71, but Prendergast kept the momentum going by hitting 37 off just 23, leading Ireland to 167-4, a target 28 more than Pakistan had ever chased. The hosts lost wickets at regular intervals but Javeria

Khan kept going, making her 50 off 36 balls but chopped on to Jane Maguire soon after.

Pakistan needed 86 off 53 balls with six wickets in hand, but only Nida Dar looked comfortable in making a 24-ball score of 26.

Arlene Kelly and Laura Delany turned the screw and bowled out Pakistan with an over to spare.

After Orla Prendergast explained that coaches Ed Joyce and Glenn Querl had given the batters freedom to be positive from start.

'Glenn has been clear with the top 3', she said, 'he backs us to play to our strengths. To back up the win over South Africa in the summer is great

for us as a team and we'll take huge confidence into the World Cup.'

Laura Delany paid tribute to her band of players, several of whom showed why the future is bright for Irish women's cricket under Ed Joyce.

'It's great to have such a young side. There's a lot of energy. The girls are fearless,' said the Ireland skipper.

'Gaby, Amy and Orla have been outstanding with the bat. It gives us a really good platform to build on and today we backed that up really well with the ball.'

'It's just great that we've ended this year on a high ahead of the World Cup in February next year.'
