Pakistan had ever chased. The hosts lost wickets at regular intervals but Javeria Khan kept going, making her 50 off 36 balls but chopped on to Jane Maguire soon after.

Pakistan needed 86 off 53 balls with six wickets in hand, but only Nida Dar looked comfortable in making a 24ball score if 26.

Arlene Kelly and Laura Delany turned the screw and bowled out Pakistan with an
