

IRELAND EDGE FRENCH FOR A PERFECT START

GOALS from Jeremy Duncan and Shane O'Donoghue handed Mark Tumilty's Ireland an important win in their opening match of the FIH Men's Hockey Nations Cup against France in South Africa. After a rain shower during the warm-up in Potchefstroom, France started the game more brightly and looked more likely to score, but it was a field goal that came from a turnover in the centre of the pitch in the 22nd minute that put Ireland in front. Player of the match John McKee won the ball and drifted forward, beating several opponents

before sliding a perfect pass into the path of the onrushing Duncan, who dived and lifted the ball over the goalkeeper. France equalised from their fourth penalty corner when Victor Charlet sent a flick like a tracer bullet between the right post and player to level. Benjamin Walker won a penalty stroke, but Thierry Arthur saved Shane O'Donoghue's effort. However, O'Donoghue made up for that miss in the third quarter when his powerful drag went under Arthur's foot. Coach Tumilty said: 'I'm delighted with the win. This group showed a real bit of character today to dig out that result. So now our focus turns towards the Pakistan game and seeing if can we build

WEXFORD defender Shaun Murphy has announced his

retirement from inter-county hurling after a decade-long career. The Oulart-The Ballagh player was a key member of the Davy

Fitzgerald-managed side that won a first Leinster title in 15 years in 2019, beating Kilkenny in the final before losing to Tipperary in the semi-final of the All-Ireland. Murphy joined the Wexford senior squad for the 2012 National League campaign and made his championship debut against Offaly that same year. 'After 11 years with Wexford, I think now is the right time to announce my retirement from inter-county hurling,' said the 32-year-old. 'It was an honour and privilege to wear the Purple and Gold and I am very grateful to have had the opportunity.'

FORMER world champion Stuart Bingham suffered a shock first-round defeat at the BetVictor Scottish

Open in Edinburgh. Bingham, who won the world title seven years ago, lost 4-3 to fellow Essex potter Zak Surety. Jack Lisowski beat Ireland's Gerard Greene 4-1 after breaks of 105, 89 and 93 saw him reel off three frames in succession to close out the match. Judd Trump beat Sanderson Lam 4-0, while newly-crowned UK champion Mark Allen defeated Andy Lee 4-1.

IEUAN Evans has been appointed chair of the Welsh Rugby Union. The former Wales and British and Irish Lions wing - who also chairs the Lions board - takes over from Rob Butcher, the WRU announced yesterday.
