Prior to commencement of any works in the public domain, and in order to comply with The Roads Act 1993 Section 13 Paragraph 10, a Road Opening Licence must be secured from South Dublin County Council, Roads Maintenance Department.

Description:

Increase the overall height of the existing front boundary wall to a proposed height of 2m; completed wall will be the same specification as the existing wall.

It is the policy of SDCC to limit boundary walls and gates at vehicle access points to a maximum height of 0.9m in order to maintain forward visibility for egressing drivers in order to protect pedestrians and vulnerable footpath users.

Roads Recommend Refusal.

SDCC Roads Dept. deems that the proposed raising of the boundary wall to 2m would reduce forward visibility for vehicle egressing the site which would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard.
