I refer to the request for planning permission for the above development, details of which were received by the Irish Aviation Authority from the Council.

It is the observation of the Safety Regulation Division, Aerodromes that the applicant should be required to engage with Weston Airport and the Property Management Branch of the Department of Defence for Casement Aerodrome to undertake a preliminary screening assessment to confirm that the proposed development and any associated cranes that would be utilised during its construction would have no impact on the safety of flight operations at Weston Aerodrome and Casement Aerodrome."

"In the event of planning consent being granted, the applicant should be conditioned to contacting the Irish Aviation Authority, Weston Airport and Casement Aerodrome in relation to all crane operations, with a minimum of 30 days prior notification of their erection.

A suitable marking and lighting scheme shall be agreed with the Authority prior to commencement of construction. Additional information regarding crane type (tower,

mobile), elevation of the highest point of crane, dimensions of crane, ground elevation and location co-ordinates (WGS-84 format) will also be required by the Authority to allow for an aviation safety assessment.
