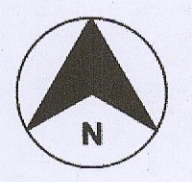
VEGETATION

-  Maintained and protected existing Scrub Thicket
-  Semi-mature Feature Trees
-  Medium/Large Street Trees
-  Medium Street Trees
-  Proposed parkland trees (standard, 2m clear stem), species as follows: *Betula pendula* 8-10cm, 3-4m ht, *Pyrus 'Chanticleer'*, 14-16cm, 3-4m ht, *Crataegus monogyna*, 14-16cm, 3-4m ht, *Sorbus aucuparia*, 12-14cm, 2.5-3.5m ht
-  Large Shrubs
-  Species rich meadow grassland incorporating shade tolerant understorey to ecology corridor
-  Wildflower planting
-  Proposed native Hedge planting (Dim: 60-80cm transplants at 5m m, or 1m canopies in buffer zone, *Corylus avellana* - 20%, *Crataegus europaeus* - 30%, *Ilex aquifolium* - 5%, *Ligustrum vulgare* - 5%, *Prunus spinosa* - 30%, *Sambucus nigra* - 10%)
-  Proposed formal hedge planting (Dim: Height varies from 1100 to 1500mm to match railing, Planted in staggered rows of single species 60-90cm at 3m, *Carpinus betulus*, *Ilex crenata*)
-  Grass - Public realm
-  Private grass
-  Bulb Planting
-  Communal / Private Low / Medium Ornamental Shrubs, Climbers and Perennials
-  Low maintenance Perennials and ornamental Grass
-  Swale Planting
-  Bioretention Area
